READ: ISAIAH 13:6

- 6 **Wail, for the day of the LORD is at hand! It will come as destruction from the Almighty.**

READ: ISAIAH 2:12

- 2 **The day of the LORD of hosts shall come upon everything proud and lofty, upon everything lifted up And it shall be brought low.**

READ: EZEKIEL 30:3

- 3 **The day is near, Even the day of the LORD is near. It will be a day of clouds, the time of the Gentiles.**

- 35 **Some of those of understanding shall fall, to refine them, purify them, and make them white, until the time of the end; because it is still for the appointed time.**

READ: DANIEL 12:10

- 10 **Many shall be purified, made white, and refined, but the wicked shall do wickedly; and none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.**

READ: 2 THESSALONIANS 2:3-4

- 3 **Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,**
- 4 **Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.**

READ: EZEKIEL 11:23

23 The glory of the LORD went up from the midst of the city and stood on the mountain, which is on the east side of the city.

READ: JOEL 3:12

12 Let the nations be wakened, and come up to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. For there I will sit to judge all the surrounding nations.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:4-6

5 **You shall flee through My mountain valley, for the mountain valley shall reach to Azal.** Yes, you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. Thus the LORD my God will come and all the saints with You.

**WHY SHOULD THEY FLEE?

READ: ISAIAH 66:15

15 **Behold, the LORD will come with fire** And with His chariots, **like a whirlwind, To render His anger with fury, And His rebuke with flames of fire.**

READ: ISAIAH 29:6

29 **You will be punished by the LORD of hosts** **With thunder and earthquake and great noise, With storm and tempest** And the flame of devouring fire.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:4-6

5 You shall flee through My mountain valley, for the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. **Yes, you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah.** Thus the LORD my God will come and all the saints with You.

WHAT HAPPENED IN THE DAYS OF UZZIAH?

READ: AMOS 1:1

1 The words of Amos, **who was among the sheep breeders of Tekoa**, which he saw concerning Israel in the days of Uzziah king of Judah, and in the days of Jeroboam the son of Joash, **king of Israel**, two years before the earthquake.

READ: ISAIAH 6:1

1 **In the year that King Uzziah died**, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, **high and lifted up**, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:4-6

5 You shall flee through My mountain valley, for the mountain valley shall reach to Azal. Yes, you shall flee as you fled from the earthquake in the days of Uzziah king of Judah. **Thus the LORD my God will come and all the saints with You.**

READ: MATTHEW 16:27

27 **The Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.**

READ: MATTHEW 25:31

31 **When the Son of Man comes in His glory and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory.**

READ: 1 THESSALONIANS 3:13

13 **So that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.**

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:4-6

READ: JUDE 14-15

14 Enoch, **the seventh from Adam**, prophesied about these men also, **saying**, Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints.

15 To execute judgment on all, to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have committed in an ungodly way, and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.

10 **For the stars of heaven and their constellations will not give their light.** The sun will be darkened in its going forth and the moon will not cause its light to shine.

18 **Woe to you who desire the day of the LORD!** For **what good**
is the day of the LORD to you? It will be darkness and **not light.**

WHEN WILL THIS DAY OCCUR?

READ: MATTHEW 24:36

36 **Of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.**

READ: MARK 13:32

32 **Of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.**

READ: LUKE 21:34

34 **But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly.**

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

7 **It shall be one day which is known to the LORD;** neither day nor night. But at evening time it shall happen that it will be light.

WHAT DAY IS THIS?

READ: JEREMIAH 30:7

7 **Alas! That day is great, so that none is like it. It is the time of Jacob's trouble** but **he shall be saved out of it.**

READ: LUKE 21:25

25 **There will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars;** and **on the earth distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea and the waves roaring;**

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

7 It shall be one day which is known to the LORD; neither day nor night. But at evening time it shall happen that it will be light.

WHY IS THERE NO DAY NOR NIGHT?

READ: ISAIAH 13:10

10 The stars of heaven and their constellations will not give their light. The sun will be darkened in its going forth and the moon will not cause its light to shine.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT EVENING TIME?

READ: ISAIAH 30:26

26 The light of the moon will be as the light of the sun, And the light of the sun will be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, In the day that the LORD binds up the bruise of His people and heals the stroke of their wound.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

7 It shall be one day which is known to the LORD; neither day nor night. But at evening time it shall happen that it will be light.

WHAT WILL BE THE LIGHT?

READ: ISAIAH 60:19

19 The sun shall no longer be your light by day, Nor for brightness shall the moon give light to you. But the LORD will be to you an everlasting light, And your God your glory.

READ: REVELATION 21:23

23 The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb is its light.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

8 In that day it shall be that living waters shall flow from Jerusalem, Half of them toward the eastern sea And half of them toward the western sea; In both summer and winter it shall occur.

WHAT LIVING WATERS WILL FLOW FROM JERUSALEM?

READ: EZEKIEL 47:1-2

1 He brought me back to the door of the temple and there was water, flowing from under the threshold of the temple toward the east, for the front of the temple faced east. The water was flowing from under the right side of the temple, south of the altar.

2 He brought me out by way of the north gate and led me around on the outside to the outer gateway that faces east and there was water, running out on the right side.

READ: JOEL 3:18

18 It will come to pass in that day that the mountains shall drip with new wine, The hills shall flow with milk and all the brooks of Judah shall be flooded with water. A fountain shall flow from the house of the LORD and water the Valley of Acacias.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

8 In that day it shall be that living waters shall flow from Jerusalem, Half of them toward the eastern sea And half of them toward the western sea; In both summer and winter it shall occur.

WHAT IS THIS LIVING WATER?

READ: JOHN 4:10-12

10 Jesus said to her, If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, Give Me a drink, you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.

11 The woman said to Him, Sir, You have nothing to draw with and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water ?

READ: JOHN 7:38

38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

8 In that day it shall be that living waters shall flow from Jerusalem, **Half of them toward the eastern sea** And **half of them toward the western sea**; In both summer and winter it shall occur.

READ: EZEKIEL 47:18

18 **On the east side you shall mark out the border from between Hauran and Damascus** and **between Gilead and the land of Israel, along the Jordan** and **along the eastern side of the sea. This is the east side.**

WHAT IS THE WESTERN SEA? **MEDITERRANEAN SEA?**

READ: DEUTERONOMY 11:24-25

24 **Every place on which the sole of your foot treads shall be yours: from the wilderness and Lebanon, from the river, the River Euphrates, even to the Western Sea, shall be your territory.**

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

READ: PSALMS 22:28

28 The kingdom is the LORD'S and He rules over the nations.

READ: PSALMS 47:7

7 God is the King of all the earth. Sing praises with understanding.

READ: DANIEL 2:44

44 In the days of these kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which shall never be destroyed. The kingdom shall not be left to other people. It shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms. And it shall stand forever.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

9 And **the LORD shall be King over all the earth**. In that day it shall be **The LORD is one, and His name one**.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO THE KINGDOM?

READ: REVELATION 11:15

15 **The seventh angel sounded: There were loud voices in heaven, saying, the kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ. And He shall reign forever and ever!**

READ: 1 CORINTHIANS 15:24

24 **Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father; when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power.**

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

9 And the LORD shall be King over all the earth. In that day it shall be the LORD is one and His name one.

HOW SHALL ALL BE MADE ONE?

READ: JOHN 17:21-23

21 That they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You. That they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

22 And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:

23 I in them, and You in Me; that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me, and have loved them as You have loved Me.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:7-9

9 And the LORD shall be King over all the earth. In that day it shall be The LORD is one and His name one.

READ: EPHESIANS 4:3-6

- 3 Endeavor to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- 4 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling;
- 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism
- 6 One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.

READ: ZECHARIAH 14:10-11

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:10-11

10 All the land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be raised up and inhabited in her place from Benjamin's Gate to the place of the First Gate and the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king's winepresses.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO THE LAND AROUND JERUSALEM?

READ: ISAIAH 40:4

4 Every valley shall be exalted And every mountain and hill brought low. The crooked places shall be made straight And the rough places smooth.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:10-11

10 All the land shall be turned into a plain from Geba to Rimmon south of Jerusalem. Jerusalem shall be raised up and inhabited in her place from Benjamin's Gate to the place of the First Gate and the Corner Gate, and from the Tower of Hananel to the king's winepresses.

WHERE IS RIMMON? SOUTHERN BORDER OF JUDAH?

READ: 1 CHRONICLES 6:77

77 The tribe of Zebulun the rest of the children of Merari were given Rimmon with its common-lands and Tabor with its common-lands.

WHERE IS GEBA? NORTHERN BORDER OF JUDAH?

READ: 2 CHRONICLES 16:6

6 King Asa took all Judah and they carried away the stones and timber of Ramah, which Baasha had used for building and with them he built Geba and Mizpah.

QUESTIONS: ZECHARIAH 14:10-11
